

TOMATO VARIETIES

Tomato plant varieties (subject to availability)

Moneymaker - An excellent variety of tomato to grow if you have poor soil, or if we have a poor Summer Indeterminate (cordon) variety of tomato (best grown up a cane). Should be stopped at the 5th truss. Excellent uniform, red billiard ball size fruit. Good in poor soils and conditions. Can be grown inside or out.

Gardener's Delight - the most famous small tomato, fruits abundantly for a long season in large clusters of sweet bit size tomatoes.

Supersweet 100 - an early-maturing cordon type, which produces heavy crops of small red fruits. It can either be grown in the greenhouse or used in containers on the patio and has excellent flavour.

Alicante - A tried and tested variety with good size fruit over a long growing season.

Peardrops - A great small pear-shaped yellow tom, really sweet and tasty.

Outdoor girl - A new introduction which is hardier than most fruit. Can be grown indoors or outdoors, medium size fruits, good disease resistance.

Shirley - Another tried and tested variety, a 'breakfast' tomato with good flavour and a decent cropper.

There will be more varieties available in 3 to 4 weeks' time.
